

Privacy Policy - LinkSpy

Last update: 16.06.2019

Privacy Policy describes how LinkSpy treat personal information related to usage of our Website and Service, including the information you have to provide using the Service. Private Policy describes the options available to you regarding our use of your personal information and how you can access, update and delete this information. We protect our customer privacy and takes responsibility regarding the security of it.

LinkSpy is dedicated to adults over 18 years old. We do not knowingly seek or collect any personal information or data from persons who have not attained this age. If we recognize any users under this age, their personal information will be deleted as soon as possible.

Data Collection

We collect personal information automatically when you use the Website or Service or directly when you provide such data to us. We collect your personal information when you complete registration form and use the services on our Website, subscribe to a newsletter, email list, submit feedback, or initiate any communication with LinkSpy.

You can use some parts of the Service without having an account. In this case we collect your IP address, country of origin and other non-personal information about your computer or device like web requests, browser type, browser language, referring URL, operating system and date and time of requests that will be recorded for log file information. If you have an Account, this information will also be recorded and may be associated with your Account.

Creating an Account is required for using other features of the Service. We require certain information about you at registration, including your email address and password. Your IP address is recorded automatically whenever you access the Service and may be associated with your Account. Any other information or content you provide us on the Service will be saved and associated with your account.

We may collect and record information related to your usage of url shorteners such as logins, passwords, API keys and other data of url shorteners. We will also keep information such as store time, IP address, user agent, browser language and any other of your activities on the Service. If you place our links on the websites you own, we will also gather information about your website's visitors: visit time, device type, operation system, IP address, location, useragent,

browser language, ISP and other statistics. If you have registered and are logged in, we may associate that information with your Account.

We may keep a record of any correspondence between you and LinkSpy like support requests, emails and live chats.

When you use the Service, we may send cookies and web beacon to your computer to uniquely identify your browser session to provide all the features of the Service.

In case of change to our Website and/or Service that will cause the need of change of usage of your personal information not contemplated by the Privacy Policy is needed, we will obtain your consent before such collection and / or use.

In order to view, amend, erase, or correct your Collected Information, contact LinkSpy Support. All requests will be answered up to one month.

Data Usage

We will use the information you give us to provide you with the Service and to maintain and improve the Service.

LinkSpy takes the privacy of Publishers very seriously. Thus, we do not sell, rent, or otherwise provide your personal data to third parties for marketing purposes. However, some of your information (such as logins, passwords, API keys) will be shared with url shorteners, to provide you with the Service.

We may use your email or other personal information for non-marketing or administrative purposes, including for correspondence or to inform you regarding changes in our Service.

We may also use email or other personal information to periodically send you marketing information about the Service, such as new LinkSpy functionality, LinkSpy news and information, however, you may opt-out of such messages by editing your account settings.

We use cookies, pixels and other technologies to store information so that you will not have to re-enter it on future visits, provide personalized content and information, monitor the effectiveness of the Service and monitor aggregate metrics such as the number of visitors and links views.

If you do not wish for these and any other cookies to track you, we recommend that you use an internet browser which will allow you to disable them. You can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in your Internet browser's "help" directory. If you reject cookies, you may still use our Website, but your ability to use some areas of our Service will be limited.

When you use the Service, you may encounter two types of cookies, "first party" cookies that are ours and "third party" cookies which are found in other companies' internet tools which are used in conjunction with the Service to enhance it.

Please note that the use of cookies by our service providers, partners, affiliates or other 3rd party assets (such as social media) on the Website is not covered by our privacy policy. These 3rd parties may use cookies, clear gifs, images, and scripts to help them better manage their content on our Website. We do not have access or control over their cookies.

We use Collected Information related to Personal Content when you provide consent or otherwise request us to do so, as well as when necessary to provide the services you requested.

Please note that, as with any other content placed on the Internet, any content on Your Websites which you use in relation to the Service may be viewed by other users of the Service and other internet users and you are responsible for such content.

Place of data storage and processing

Personal data will be stored on secure servers that are managed by LinkSpy and our service providers located in France, Germany, Poland, United States, Canada, and may change actively. Your personal information can be accessed by LinkSpy's employees. We do this based on your consent to this policy. We take all possible care to protect your personal information.

The Site and Third Party Sites

Our Website and Service includes / uses links to other third-parties Websites whose privacy practices may differ from those of LinkSpy. Any such third-party technology may collect information from you or use other services or technologies that collect information from you.
